

Agency Membership

The California Park & Recreation Society has created a special category for city, county, district, state, federal and nonprofit agencies. Agency members receive all the benefits of membership in CPRS, including voting rights.

As an advocate for the park and recreation field, CPRS serves not only individual professionals, but also the agencies and organizations for which they work. The Society focuses on issues important to agencies and organizations, such as youth development and public safety. City, county and district policymakers can keep abreast of issues, such as legislation that can affect annual budgets. Hospitals and therapeutic recreation facilities have access to resources from CPRS. Nonprofit groups—who work in the field of recreation and community services—benefit through professional affiliation and networking.
