


I look around at the smiling faces at the movies or concerts in the park and know how lucky I am to give back through Parks & Recreation.



San Elijo Lagoon Ecological Reserve

On this casual stroll, Rangers Beth, Allison and Farrah will point out some of the birds that live in and migrate through the lagoon, which sits along the Pacific Flyway. Look up, out and around you to view birds like the endangered Ridgway's rail, Belding's Savannah sparrows, Great egrets, snowy egrets, double-crested cormorants, ospreys, and more. They'll also talk about the restoration project underway, and the other animals that thrive in this healthy estuary. As an added perk, they'll have real, live birds of prey with them: A Great Horned Owl and an American Kestrel. See these local raptors up close while learning how they hunt, where they nest and how they contribute to local ecosystems.


SNORES AND SMORES






