ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

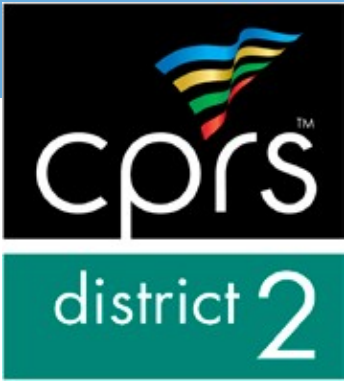
