

Esports Programs

- "Esports Communities" vs. "Esports Events"
 - o WHERE gamers LIVE & INTERACT together vs. WHAT gamers DO together

Types of Events

- Tournaments: single-game competitive events, resulting in a winner
- Leagues: series of events or competitions over a period of time (i.e. 8-week season, single-game focused, like intramural sports)
- Socials: themed events to encourage participation and engagement (i.e. Mario Kart Mondays, Fortnite Fridays)
- Educational: teamwork, skill-building, gaming tactics & strategies, STEM, friendly competition (i.e. Beat-the-Coach battles)
- Staff Training: Certification programs for Program Directors, Tournament Organizers, Live Commentators, and Game Coaches




