2. Legislation

- Cindy Bagley & Doug Houston have been working to find guidelines for the re-opening of leisure services – working with the CA Recreation District Association.
- El Cajon shared that the San Diego cities are going to default guidelines to the school guidelines if the state/counties don't release any regarding re-opening youth and adult recreation services.
- Roseville is moving ahead on opening services (classes and programs) with special event organizers needing to submit a covid-19 plan.
- Hermosa is having their special event organizers go through the county with the applications. Then, they bring the "green light" back to the City of Hermosa as proof that they will follow the guidelines
- Senior Centers are starting to re-open. Agencies in northern CA have not opened as much.
- AB 2257: Clean Up bill to AB 5
 - Contract Instructors can be used as they were prior to AB 5, but it will be dependent on each city attorney's discretion.

3. Action Items

- AB 1227: Check with each of our Districts which cities run their own theatre to report back. This would be where the cities run the theatre (operate their own programs) vs. those who rent it out.
- Continue to engage the members with the A-Team
