THE BEGINNING

- March 13 – Received call County may shutdown on Monday
- March 16 – All administrative staff sent home, field staff reduced
- March 17 – All Parks Entrance Fees suspended
- March 18 – Specialty Parks and certain activities closed
 - first reports of parking lots filling up with park visitors
- April 3,4 – Stanford Seroprevalence Study
- April 4,5 – Persian New Year
- April 12 - Easter

STAFFING PLANS

Administrative staff sent home

Park Ranger staff – one opener/one closer, 1-2 days wfh

Park Maintenance staff – 3 days in parks, 2 days wfh

By end of April, most field staff full time

COUNTY HEALTH ORDER

Determines allowed activities

Department reviews and interprets new Health Order after each update

Department clarification with EOC, County Counsel, Dr. Smith, Dr. Cody

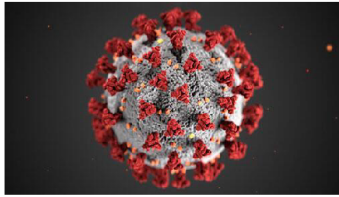
COVID-19 PROTOCOLS County Park Facilities

In order to minimize exposure to others, these new restrictions have been put into place!

- Do not enter the facility if you have COVID-19 symptoms.
- Maintain a minimum 6 ft distance from others, including when in line.
- Sneeze and cough into a cloth or tissue or, if not available, into your elbow.
- Face coverings required to enter (except if 6 years of age or under or medically inadvisable).
- Do not shake hands or engage in any unnecessary physical contact.
- Personnel can call the County of Santa Clara Office of Labor Standards Enforcement at 1-866-870-7725 to report any deficiencies in compliance with Protocol Requirements.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS Field Sports Park

In order to minimize exposure to others, these new restrictions have been put into place!

- Online reservations required.
- All persons must always maintain a minimum of 6ft of physical distancing from other persons.
- Allowed use is limited to a single shooter or within members of your household.
- All Online Liability Forms must be agreed to and signed prior to arriving at the range.
- Wearing a face mask is strongly urged. A mask should always be on your person and readily available
- Groups and gatherings are prohibited.
- All picnic tables and BBQ-pits are closed and off-limits for use.
- No walk-ins will be allowed.
- No equipment sharing.
- All brass, casing, shotgun shells etc. will remain Santa Clara County property once they hit the ground.
- Avoid congregating together when entering and exiting Ranges and parking lots.
- Follow entry and exit travel.
- If you are not feeling well, have a fever, cough, or are otherwise unwell, do not use Ranges. Please cancel your reservation prior to leaving your home. Please contact your health provider ASAP.
- In addition to Covid-19 requirements, all Santa Clara County Field Sports Park Range rules, all other CA State, County Park & Local restrictions apply.
- Please follow all guidelines & recommendations from the CDC, State and County Public Health Departments.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS Hellyer County Park Disc Golf Course

Physical Distancing Rules must be followed for play on all courses or areas will be closed!

- If you are not feeling well, have a fever or cough, return home and consult your doctor.
- SOLO PLAY OR WITH MEMBERS OF YOUR HOUSEHOLD ONLY!
- Keep a physical distance of at least 6' when encountering other players at all times.
- Do not touch other players' discs, towels, bags, or carts out on the course.
- DO NOT SHARE EQUIPMENT with other players.
- When approaching a tee box occupied by another player allow player to throw and start walking toward disc before occupying the tee box.
- NO GATHERING. Congregating on the course or in the parking lot is NOT ALLOWED.
- Face masks are strongly urged. You should have a mask on your person and ready for use.
- Follow all guidelines & recommendations from the CDC, State, and County Public Health Departments.
