Dear Potential Scholarship Recipient,

The California Park and Recreation Society District 9 welcomes your interest in applying for our 2023 undergraduate or graduate scholarship award(s). The scholarship winner(s) will be selected and awarded up to \$1,000.00. In addition, the scholarship recipient will receive free District 9 trainings for one-year and a one-year CPRS student membership which entitles them to a discounted registration to the annual CPRS Conference.

The following are prerequisites for applying:

- 1. You reside, work or attend an accredited college in the District 9 area. Please refer to Attachment A for District 9 geographical boundaries.
- 2. You maintain a full-time student status of 12 semester units minimum (or quarter equivalent) or a part-time status of 6 semester units minimum (or quarter equivalent) and work 10-40 hours a week (to be verified). Graduate students must maintain 9 semester units for full-time student status or maintain 3 semester units and work 10-40 hours a week for part-time status.
- 3. You are majoring in Recreation, Leisure Studies, Parks, Physical Education, Public Administration, Kinesiology, Gerontology or a closely related field and maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- 4. You are seeking a career in the recreation or parks profession.
- 5. You are not a current board member of CPRS District 9.

A panel will review and evaluate each application on the basis of prerequisite qualifications, resume content and character references. Candidates with the best qualifications will be invited to an oral interview at a date and time to be determined. The completed packet (application form, resume, two reference forms, official or unofficial transcripts, or two most recent report cards) is **due by Monday, March 6th, 2023 at 5:00 p.m**. Mail packets to the address below. *Scanned or emailed applications are also accepted.

Note: The reference forms should be completed by your reference, placed in a sealed envelope and returned along with your application packet. Letters of recommendation will not be accepted. At least one reference must be an instructor. *Professor may email the document directly to CPRS rep.
